School grading...

Further, Chhatarpur followed Morena by earning 1.82 marks out of 2. Damoh took the third spot with 1.64 marks out of 2. Instructions to take corrective actions:The state education department has issued a notice to all the district collectors and district education officers (DEOs) to note the ranking and analyse their districts. Furthermore, department director Dhanraju S said, “The analytical figure depicts the quality of education across the state and it is expected that all the districts will work on taking corrective actions for improving their ranking.”

Air India...

Prime Minister Modi highlighted the growing strength in the civil aviation sector which was an important aspect of national infrastructure. He said according to estimates India will need more than 2,000 aircraft in the next 15 years.

In his comments, Macron said the deal highlighted the bond between Paris and New Delhi. “I want to tell everybody that for me, this is a very important contract and this achievement today is one of the milestones of the in-depth strategic and friendly partnership we have between India and France,” he said. Aviation sources said that the two deals would transform the former national carrier and help it leapfrog as market leader. The deals are part of an ambitious plan to return to profitability in the world’s third-biggest air transport market, market analysts pointed out.

According to Airbus forecasts, India’s air traffic is expected to grow 6.6 per cent a year over the next two decades, almost twice the global average. The European aircraft manufacturer already has an engineering centre in India and sources some components from Indian suppliers. Air India is the country’s largest international carrier, but its domestic market share stood at only 8.6 percent in September.

Market sources said that Air India is aiming to take a 30 percent domestic share by the end of 2027 while expanding its fleet to cover more international routes.

The shopping list given to the American company comprises 20 Boeing 787s and 10 Boeing 777-9s wide-body aircraft, and 190 Boeing 737 MAX single-aisle aircraft.

‘G20 nations...

Stating that India has made significant progress in agriculture, Scindia said tops in milk production, is second in growing vegetables and fruits and third in food grains production. “India’s food grains output has risen from 265 million tonnes to 315 million tonnes in the last eight years. The budgetary outlay for the farm sector has been increased by four-and-half times to USD 10.5 billion (around Rs 86,700 crore) in the last eight years,” he added. Contd. on P6

Scindia also mentioned that Madhya Pradesh too has made significant progress in the farm sector and is a major producer of soya and garlic. The state’s food grains output increased almost 4 times to 629 lakh tonnes from 165 lakh tonnes in the last 18 years. Irrigation has improved by 50 per cent in the state, he said.

“Based on the outcome of the discussion, India and G-20 nations will provide a new road map for agriculture to the world,” he said.

Entire Madhya Pradesh is my family, if my family is happy then my becoming Chief Minister is successful. Your happiness, the happiness on your face makes our life meaningful,” said Chouhan

From Gwalior airport, Cheetahs would be taken to Kuno National Park by helicopter,” said one of the Cheetah Task Force Committee members.

“As many as 10 big enclosures have been prepared for the arriving 12 cheetahs” said Kuno National Park Director Uttam Sharma to Free Press.

The arriving cheetahs would be first kept in quarantine and once their quarantine period is over, they would be shifted to their enclosures. With this, the number of Cheetahs at Kuno National Park would increase from eight to twenty.

Sources also said that Cheetah Committee Members quizzed KNP Director Uttam Sharma and DFO Prakash Varma about the preparations made at park for the arriving 12 cheetahs.

BJP received Rs 614 cr as donation, Cong Rs 94 crore in 2021-22: ADR

NEW DELHI

The BJP received Rs 614 crore as donation in 2021-22, while the Congress got Rs 95 crore, according to poll reform body ADR. According to a report by the Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR), the total donations (above Rs 20, 000) declared by the national parties for 2021-22 was Rs 780.774 crore from 7,141 donations.

“A total of Rs 614.63 crore from 4,557 donations was declared by the BJP, followed by Rs 95.46 crore from 1,255 donations declared by Congress. The donations declared by the BJP

are more than three times the aggregate declared by the Congress, NCP, CPI, CPI(M), NPEP and AITC for the same period,” the ADR said.

The Bahujan Samaj Party (SP) declared it did not receive any donation above Rs 20,000 during 2021-22 as it has been declaring for the past 16 years, the ADR said.

The total donations of the national parties during 2021-22 rose by Rs 187.03 crore, an increase of 31.50 per cent from 2020-21. Donations to the BJP rose from Rs 477.55 in 2020-21 crore during to Rs 614.63 crore 2021-22, up 28.71 per cent, in a year.

High-voltage campaign for Tripura polls ends

AGARTALA

The high-voltage campaign for the Tripura assembly elections ended on Tuesday, a top poll official said. Polling to the 60-member assembly will be held on February 16 and votes will be counted on March 3.

“The campaign for the assembly elections ended at 4 pm on Tuesday without any major law and order issue. The poll machinery is geared up to conduct free, fair and peaceful elections on February 16,” Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) Gite Kirankumar Dinakararao told PTI.

Polling will take place in 3,328 polling booths, out of which 1,100 are sensitive and 28 are categorised as critical, he said. During the month-long campaign, Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Union Home Minis-



ter Amit Shah, BJP president J P Nadda and a dozen central ministers canvassed in favour of candidates of the saffron party. The BJP organised ‘Vijay Sankalp Yatra, rallies and roadshows to woo the electors.

CPI(M) general secretary Sitaram Yechury, and senior leaders Prakash Karat, Brinda Karat and Moham-

ad Salim, along with former CM Manik Sarkar and party state secretary Jitendra Choudhury campaigned in favour of the party. Congress leaders Adhir Chowdhury, Dipa Dasmunshi and AICC general secretary Ajay Kumar campaigned for the grand old party, but neither Rahul Gandhi nor Priyanka Gandhi Vadra visited

the state for campaigning.

Former royal scion Pradyot Kishore Manikya Debbarma single-handedly canvassed for his Tipra Motha party.

While the BJP’s star campaigners highlighted the development that has taken place in the northeastern state in the last five years, the Left Front and the Congress stressed on “misrule and misgovernance” of the BJP-IPFT government. Tipra Motha, a regional political party contesting 42 assembly constituencies, stressed on its Greater Tipraland statehood demand.

Adequate security measures have been taken across the state and along the international border with Bangladesh, a senior police officer said. A total of 259 candidates are in the electoral race, of whom 20 are women.

‘Big drop in terror cases in J&K after Art 370 abrogation’

KARNAL (HARYANA)

Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Tuesday said there is a big drop in terror incidents in Jammu and Kashmir after the abrogation of Article 370 and a record number of tourists are visiting the Union Territory. Presenting the President’s Colour to the Haryana Police in recognition of its exceptional service, Shah also said the BJP government at the Centre has successfully tackled internal security challenges — terror activities in Jammu and Kashmir, insurgency in the North East and Left Wing Extremism — in the last eight years.

“Today I can say with satisfaction that after the abrogation of Article 370, there is a big reduction in terror incidents in Jammu and Kashmir. And record

He tweeted, “Remembering our valorous heroes who we lost on this day in Pulwama. We will never forget their supreme sacrifice. Their courage motivates us to build a strong and developed India.” Over 40 soldiers had made the supreme sacrifice after a suicide bomber rammed his vehicle into the CRPF convoy. In a retaliatory attack, the Indian Air Force targeted terror camps in Balakot in Pakistan.

The Union Home minister also said the Narendra Modi government will bring changes in the Criminal Procedure Code, the Indian Penal Code and the Evidence Act to make forensic investigation compulsory for crimes which attract punishment of six years or more.

“Under the leadership of the Prime Minister, the Home department is tackling several internal security challenges effectively. Jammu and Kashmir, the North East and Left Wing Extremism, the pain of which the country suffered for many decades,” Shah said in his address. The Union minister said the Modi government achieved a big success in curbing terrorism in Jammu and Kashmir.

Man held for threatening to kill Union minister

HAJIPUR (BIHAR)

Police on Tuesday arrested a young man, who had threatened to kill Union minister and senior BJP leader from Bihar Nityanand Rai in a video that has gone viral on social media. According to Kumar Manish, the Superintendent of Police, Vaishali, the accused Madhav Jha (25) was arrested from Town police station area early in the morning.

Rai, the Minister of State for Home, is scheduled to take part in a procession here on the occasion of Mahashivratri later this week and Jha, in the video, had spoken of “firing two bullets” on the leader on the occasion. “The accused claims he had dreams of killing the minister and he disclosed the same in the video. Further investigation is underway,” the SP said.

India doesn’t give sermons to nations in need of aid: Rajnath

BENGALURU: India does not believe in giving “sermons or cut-and-dried” solutions to countries in need of assistance and holds that nations with superior military powers do not have the right to dictate solutions to others, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh said on Tuesday in an apparent reference to China’s assertive behaviour.

In an address to his counterparts and deputy defence ministers from around 30 countries at Aero India, Singh said India has always stood for a rules-based global order in which the primordial instinct of “might being right” is replaced by fairness, respect and equality amongst all sovereign nations.

Without naming China or any other country, Singh said the “top-down approach” towards solving problems has never been sustainable, adding often it leads to “debt trap, reaction from the local population and conflict.” While referring to India’s emphasis on collective approach, Singh talked about how the COVID-19 pandemic originated in “one country” and how in no time, it had a devastating impact on the whole world, adding the crisis once again underscored the point that “we are all in the same boat and we either sink or swim together.” In the conclave named SPEED (Shared Prosperity through Enhanced Engagements in Defence), Singh also called for united efforts to counter pressing challenges like terrorism and said collective security has become “sine-qua non” for overall development and prosperity of nations.

K’taka Congress love-hate messages to BJP on V-Day

The Karnataka Congress showered love on rival BJP in Karnataka on Valentine’s Day though most of the messages were soaked in sarcasm. Sharing caricature memes of Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai and his cabinet members, the tweets shared by Karnataka Congress’s official handle said, “Happy Valentine’s Day BJP”.

Sharing a caricature of Bommai with a guitar in hand and hearts with “40%” written on them, the Congress took potshots at the charge of 40% commission being allegedly collected by few ministers for public works. The Congress wrote, “BJP has pure love for 40%. The love for a 40% commission is more passionate than the love of Romeo and Juliet!”

For BJP state President Nalin Kumar Kateel, the Congress wrote, “BJP people

flirt with cows, not love!” Kateel had criticised the Congress over the anti-cow slaughter law in Karnataka. BJP MP Tejasvi Surya, who was accused of opening the emergency exit of an IndiGo aircraft, was also not spared.

Other BJP leaders who were attacked in the series of memes include Health and Family Welfare Minister K Sudhakar, former Union minister Basanagouda Patil, BJP national general secretary CT Ravi, former minister KS Eshwarappa and state Home Minister Araga Jnanendra.

Country pays homage to slain CRPF jawans

15 of 19 militants involved in 2019 PULWAMA ATTACK killed or arrested

PTI / Pulwama / New Delhi

Fifteen of the 19 militants involved in the 2019 Pulwama attack have been either killed or arrested while the security situation in Kashmir has improved with greater synergy between agencies, officials said on Tuesday as the nation paid homage to the CRPF men killed in the terror strike.

“Nineteen terrorists were involved in the Pulwama attack, eight have been neutralised (killed) while seven arrested. Four are still at large and of them, three are Pakistanis, including (Jaish-e-Mohammed chief) Masood azhar,” Additional Director General of Police, Kashmir Zone, Vijay Kumar, said after paying tributes to the slain CRPF men at the Pulwama Martyrs’ Memorial in Lethpora, Srinagar.

Kumar also said in the last three years, the Jaish-e-Mohammed has been “wiped out” in the Kashmir Valley. Only seven to eight terrorists are active now, he said.

“The situation in Kashmir

has improved post the Pulwama attack. Stone pelting incidents do not take place anymore while ‘hartaals’ have come to an end. Record tourists are arriving in Kashmir,” CRPF Inspector General (Operations) MS Bhatia told reporters at the memorial, about 21km from Srinagar.

Several events were organised across the country to mark the fourth anniversary of the attack with the CRPF holding a series of functions, including the one at the Pulwama Martyrs’ Memorial in Kashmir’s Lethpora. Paying tribute, Prime Minister Narendra Modi tweeted, “Remembering our valorous heroes who we lost on this day in Pulwama. We will never forget their supreme sacrifice. Their courage motivates us to build a strong and developed India.”
