इंदौर । गुसाखेड़ी में रहने वाले युवक का शव सदिग्ध हालत में मिला है । उसके परिजनो ने हत्या की शंका जताई है। फिलहाल पुलिस का कहना है मामले में जांच जारी है। गुसाखेड़ी में रहने वाले धर्मोद गंधारे पिता गबू का शव कल गुसाखेड़ी क्षेत्र में ही एक लोहे के टैंक के ऊपर मिला था । गंधोद की स्कूल की छुट्टियां चल रही है। वह ठोल बजाने और टाइल्स लगाने का भी काम करता था। मामा करण का आरोप है कि उसकी किसी ने हत्या की है । उन्होंने बताया कि रात को वह तैयार होकर निकला था सुबह उसका शव मिला। उसकी जेब से डायरी मिली है जिसमें कई लोगों के नंबर हैं । आजाद नगर पुलिस ने कल धर्मोद का पीएम करवाया। पीएम रिपोर्ट के बाद ही मामले में आगे की कार्रवाई होगी।

**पत्नी से परेशान पति ने लगाई फांसी**  
इंदौर । घरेलू विवाद में पत्नी बार-बार पति की शिकायत पुलिस से कर रही थी। इससे परेशान होकर पति ने फांसी लगाकर अपनी जान दे दी। मामला आजाद नगर थाना क्षेत्र के शहिन नगर गुसाखेड़ी का है । मृतक का नाम रोहित पिता रामगुप्त है। रोहित मजदूरी करता था । रिश्तेदार के अनुसार रोहित की शादी को 5 साल बीत गए थे। पत्नी से उसका लगातार विवाद चल रहा था। पत्नी आए दिन उसकी शिकायत पुलिस से कर रही थी। इसी क्रम से वह परेशान था। कल उसके घर पर कोई नहीं था, तभी उसने फांसी लगा ली।

**माइघोन के दर्द से दुखी महिला ने खाया जहर**  
इंदौर । किशनगंज थाना क्षेत्र के रयाल टाउन में रंजना ने जहर खाकर अपनी जान दे दी। रंजना एक निजी कंपनी में काम करती थी। उन्होंने बताया कि रंजना को माइघोन की परेशानी थी। उसके सिर में असहनीय दर्द होता था। इससे वह परेशान हो जाती थी। कल भी उसे काफी दर्द था। बारम्भ्रम में जाकर उसने एलिस पी लिया। जब तबीयत बिगड़ी तो पति को बताया। इसके बाद उसे अस्पताल ले जाया गया जहां उसे मृत घोषित कर दिया गया। दोनों ही मामलों में पुलिस ने मर्ग कायम किए हैं।

**मां को बेटे ने पीट दिया**  
इन्दौर । मां को एक बेटे ने इतना लज्बूर कर दिया कि उसे पुलिस की शरण लेना पड़ी। लखीझिया पुलिस को फरियादी अनिता साहू निवासी स्क्रीन नं. 78 ने शिकायत दर्ज करवाई कि जब बड़ा बेटा चेतन ने छोटे बेटे कार्तिक के लिए पूछा कि वह कहाँ गया तब मां ने उसे बताया कि वह मामा-मामी के साथ गया है। चेतन को यह बात रास नहीं आई और गुस्से में उसने घर के सामान को नुकसान पहुंचाया । जब मां ने उसे मना किया और समझाया तो चेतन ने मां अनिता को पीट दिया। बीचबचाव करने आए छोटे बेटे कार्तिक के साथ भी मारपीट की जिससे उसे चोट लगी।

## कूटरचित प्लेट की रजिस्ट्री दिखाकर लोगों को टगने वाले दंपती गिरफ्तार

इंदौर । शहर में लोगों के साथ धोखाधड़ी संबंधी अपराधों पर अंकुश लगाने एवं इनमें सलिल बदमाशों के विरुद्ध प्रभावी कार्यवाही के निर्देश वरिष्ठ अधिकारियों द्वारा दिए गए हैं। उक्त निर्देशों के तत्तराम्य में क्राइम ब्रांच इंदौर द्वारा लगातार प्रभावी कार्यवाही की जा रही है। आवेदक डॉक्टर दीपक गवली ने पुलिस उपायुक्त अपराध शाखा इंदौर को कुछ समय पहले शिकायत की था कि, आरोपी अजय उर्फ अमन सिंह निवासी सार्धक विहार इंदौर और उनकी कथित पत्नी द्वारा प्लैट गिरवी रखने के नाम पर अमन सिंह ने प्लैट की कूट रचित रजिस्ट्री देकर उससे 5 लाख रुपये ले गया है और घर से दोनों पति पत्नी फरार हो गए हैं, काफी पता करने पर भी कोई पता नहीं चल रहा है।

आरोपी दंपति ने इसके अलावा भी सुरेश मेवाड़ा निवासी पालदा को भी इसी प्रकार उसी प्लैट को गिरवी रखने के नाम पर 16 लाख , आकाश गोरे निवासी शिवाजी नगर से 5 लाख रुपए व सतीश परमार से 5 लाख रुपए ,रवि कांत से 6 लाख लेकर इसी प्रकार मूर्ख बना कर कूट रचित प्लैट की रजिस्ट्री दिखाकर उनसे भी कुल 37 लाख लेकर फरार हो गये हैं । जबकि जिस प्लैट को आरोपी दंपति गिरवी रख कर लोगों से उगी कर थे उसे पहले ही इन्होंने बैंक से फाइनेंस कराकर लिया हुआ था। आरोपी तथा उसकी पत्नी मुंबई में जा करके अपना नाम पता मोबाइल नंबर बदल लिया था तथा चुपचाप एक प्लैट में रह रहे थे, जिन्हें क्राइम ब्रांच की टीम के द्वारा पकड़ लिया गया ।

# थाने पहुंच लड़की बोली मुझे गोली लगी है

लड़की को एमवाय भेजा, पुलिस जांच में जुटी

इंदौर। आजाद नगर थाने पर मंगलवार शाम एक लड़की पहुंची और एक लड़के के द्वारा उसे गोली मारने की जानकारी पुलिस को दी। लड़की के पैर में चोट है। पुलिस ने तत्काल उसे उपचार के लिए एमवाय अस्पताल भेजा। पुलिस अधिकारियों ने मामले में जांच की बात कही है।

घटना आजाद नगर के मदीना गेट की है। आजाद नगर थाना प्रभारी इंद्रेश त्रिपाठी के अनुसार लड़की ने नाम अलीशा निवासी ग्रीन पार्क चंदन नगर बताया है। लड़की का कहना है कि क्षेत्र के आशु बाबा ने उसे गोली मारी है। जबकि आशु की मां का कहना है



कि लड़की दो लड़कों को लेकर आई थी। आशु से लड़की का रूप के लेन-देन का पुराना कोई विवाद था। लड़की का कहना है कि आशु ने गोली चलाई है वहीं कुछ लोग बोल रहे हैं कि लड़की ने खुद गोली मारी है। मेडिकल के लिए लड़की को एमवाय भेजा गया

है। गोली लगी भी है या नहीं, अगर लगी है तो खुद से मारी गई है या दूर से मारी गई है, ये अभी स्पष्ट नहीं है। मेडिकल के बाद ही सब कुछ साफ होगा। लड़की की पुरानी रंजिश क्या है, कौन दो लड़के लड़की के साथ आए थे। उनके बारे में डिटेल टीम पता कर रही है। ये पता चला है कि लड़की का आशु के घर आना-जाना है। लड़का भी इसके घर जाता है। पिस्टल अभी नहीं मिली है। लड़की ने जो पता बताया है वहां रहती भी है या नहीं इसकी तस्दीक कर रहे हैं। लड़के के घर वाले कह रहे हैं कि लड़की नशा करती है लेकिन इस बारे में अभी कुछ भी नहीं कह सकते।

इंदौर। लखुडिया इलाके में कोचिंग जा रहा एक छात्र सड़क हादसे का शिकार हो गया। रात को एक निजी अस्पताल में उसका निधन हो गया। परिजनों ने अस्पताल प्रबंधन पर आरोप लगाते हुए रात को कलेक्टर से न्याय की गुहार लगाई। दरअसल अमित पिता रिकू सेन निवासी ईडब्ल्यूएस सम्रीला टाउनशिप तलावली चांदा उम्र 17 वर्ष कल सुबह कोचिंग जा रहा था। तभी तलावली चांदा के नजदीक सड़क हादसे का शिकार हो गया । परिजन रिकू सेन शम को इलाज के लिए राजश्री अपोलो हॉस्पिटल लेकर पहुंचे बच्चे के पैर में फ्रैक्चर था अस्पताल प्रबंधन ने

उसकी ऑपरेशन की बात कही पिता रिकू सेन का आरोप है कि बच्चा ऑपरेशन थिएटर में हंसते हुए गया था थोड़ी ही देर में उन्हें डॉक्टर ने बच्चे की मौत की खबर दे दी। ऑपरेशन के दौरान बच्चे की मौत हो गई । परिजन इसके बाद नाराज हो गए । रात को ही वह कलेक्ट्रेट इलैयाराजा के बंगले पर न्याय की गुहार लगाकर पहुंच गए। उनका आरोप था कि डॉक्टर उनके बच्चे की मौत के मामले को दबा देंगे उन्होंने न्याय की गुहार लगाई है बच्चे का पोस्टमार्टम भी डॉक्टर की पैनल से करवाने की मांग की है रात को जब परिजन कलेक्टर बंगले पहुंचे तो संयोगितागंज थाने

का फोर्स मौके पर सुरक्षा के लिए पहुंचा था परिजनों ने मांग की है कि हर हाल में उन्हें न्याय मिले।

## कंटेनर से ले उडे दवाई के कार्टून

इन्दौर । बीते दिनों सोशल मीडिया पर एक वीडियो जमकर वायरल हुआ जिसमें बदमाश द्वारा चलते ट्रक में चोरी की वारदात का अंजाम दिया था। ट्रक में रखे सामान को बदमाश रोड पर फेंकता रहा और पीछे चल रहे गाड़ी उठते रहे। ऐसा ही एक मामला तेजगढ़ी नगर पुलिस ने दर्ज किया। फरियादी कमल पिता रामसिंह सालवे ने पुलिस को शिकायत दर्ज करवाई कि खडवा रोड स्थित सिंह गौडन पेट्रोल पम्प के खनीफे कोई अज्ञात बदमाश कंटेनर का ताला और सील तोड़कर दवाई के 33 कार्टून चोरी करके ले गए।

## छात्रों की डंडों से पिटाई, दो वीडियो वायरल

इंदौर। मंगलवार को एक स्टूडेंट के बयान का वीडियो सोशल मीडिया पर सामने आने के बाद हड़कंप मच गया है। यह बयान इंदौर की एक यूनिवर्सिटी के एक स्टूडेंट का बताया गया है। स्टूडेंट के साथ मारपीट की गई है। आरोप है कि यूनिवर्सिटी के गाइस ने उसे जमकर पीटा है। घटना 25 मई की है लेकिन अब वीडियो वायरल हो रहा है। घटना के साथ मारपीट का भी एक वीडियो भी वायरल हुआ है। इस वीडियो के साथ दावा किया गया है कि घटना वाली रात सिक्वोरिटी इंचार्ज और एक सिक्वोरिटी गार्ड कार से आए जिनके पास प्लास्टिक के पाइप थे। कैम्पस में मौजूद स्टूडेंट्स को प्लास्टिक के पाइप से पीटने लगते हैं। तीन से चार स्टूडेंट्स के साथ मारपीट करते दिखाई दे रहे हैं।

घटना के बाद ही स्टूडेंट्स की तरफ से जान का खतरा बताने वाला वीडियो जारी किया है। इसी में वो कहता है कि कोई भी



हॉस्टल में आकर मुझे मार सकता है। मेरी जान को खतरा है। इस स्टूडेंट का सिक्वोरिटी इंचार्ज से सीधा क्या विवाद है, फिलहाल इसका खुलासा नहीं हुआ है। सूत्रों के मुताबिक हॉस्टल के स्टूडेंट्स और यूनिवर्सिटी प्रशासन के बीच कुछ खींचतान है। यूनिवर्सिटी प्रशासन से फ्री हैंड मिलने के बाद ही स्टूडेंट्स के साथ इस तरह मारपीट की गई है। मारपीट के बाद स्टूडेंट्स को जो चोट लगी है, उसके फोटो भी सामने आए हैं।

मामले में अभी पुलिस को शिकायत नहीं होने की बात कही है। यूनिवर्सिटी होने के कारण स्टूडेंट्स भी डरे हुए बताए जा रहे हैं। उनका कहना है कि हमारा

रिजल्ट बिगड़ सकता है। मामले को लेकर यूनिवर्सिटी प्रशासन से संपर्क किया गया। यूनिवर्सिटी के चांसलर गौरव ठकुराल से बात की गई तो उन्होंने कहा कि इस संबंध में रजिस्ट्रार ही बात करेंगे। जब रजिस्ट्रार आलोक मित्तल को फोन किया तो उनसे संपर्क नहीं हो पा रहा है। यूनिवर्सिटी के रजिस्ट्रार डॉ.आलोक मित्तल ने घटना के दो दिन बाद 27 मई को एक आदेश निकाला जिसमें कहा कि अभी तक मिली जानकारी के मुताबिक मामले की जांच की जा रही है। वहीं सिक्वोरिटी इंचार्ज अभय कुमार और सिक्वोरिटी गार्ड गोलू को अगले आदेश तक यूनिवर्सिटी कैम्पस में आने की अनुमति नहीं होगी। साथ ही तत्काल प्रभाव से हॉस्टल वार्डन डॉ.सैयद मोहम्मद आफरिनी को हॉस्टल वार्डन की ड्यूटी से सस्पेंड किया जाता है। स्टूडेंट्स अब डॉ.साक्षी सिंह से संपर्क करें।

# युवक की निर्मम हत्या करने वाले आरोपी को आजीवन कारावास

इंदौर । चाकू से गोदकर हत्या किए जाने के मामले में आरोपी को अदालत ने आजीवन कारावास की सजा से दंडित किया है। जिला अभियोजन अधिकारी संजीव श्रीवास्तव ने बताया कि न्यायालय : अविनाश शर्मा, ग्यारहवें अपर सत्र न्यायाधीश, इन्दौर, जिला इंदौर ने अभियुक्त अंकुर, उम्र 32 वर्ष, निवासी इंदौर को धारा 302 भा.दं.वि. में आजीवन कारावास एवं धारा 201 भा.दं.वि.और धारा 27 आयुध अधिनियम में 3-3 वर्ष के सश्रम कारावास व कुल 11000/- रुपये के अर्थदण्ड से दण्डित किया

है। प्रकरण में अभियोजन की ओर से पैरवी अपर लोक अभियोजक श्रीमती शोभा दशोरे द्वारा की गई। अभियोजन कहानी इस प्रकार है कि दिनांक 04.08.2012 को दोपहर करीबन 12:30 बजे सूचनाकर्ता के लड़के के मोबाइल पर मृतक की मंगेतर का कॉल आया, उसने बताया कि मृतक उसका कॉल रिसीव नहीं कर रहा है। इसके बाद मृतक की मंगेतर सूचनाकर्ता के घर गई जहां से वह, सूचनाकर्ता और उसका लड़का तीनों मृतक के प्लैट पर पहुंचे। वहां ताला लगा हुआ पाया। खून के

निशान गेट के बाहर दिख रहे थे और प्लैट के अंदर पंखा चलने की आवाज आ रही थी जिस पर सूचनाकर्ता ने अपने लड़के के मोबाइल से मामले की पुलिस कंट्रोल रूम में 100 नंबर पर दी। फर्स पर खून फैला हुआ था। ऐसा प्रतीत हो रहा था किसी ने प्लैट के अंदर घुस कर मृतक की चाकू से कई वार कर हत्या की है और बाहर से ताला लगाकर भाग गया। संपूर्ण विवेचना उपरान्त अभियोग पत्र न्यायालय में पेश किया गया, जिस पर से आरोपी अंकुर को उक्त सजा सुनाई गई।

WRESTLERS HALT IMMERSION...

However, after spending an hour and 45 minutes, they returned after several khap and political leaders urged them not to take such an extreme step. As the deadline for the immersion of the medals drew closer, senior farmer leaders Sham Singh Malik and Naresh Tikait sought five days' time from the grapplers to resolve the issue.

"The khap leaders put their turbans before us and said 'do not lose hope'. Keep the dignity of the turban and return. So we decided to wait," said wrestler Jitender Kinha, who has been a part of the protesting group. There were chaotic scenes at the Har ki Pauri as khap and farmer leaders broke the human chain of supporters to reach out to the grapplers, even as thousands of devotees, who had gathered on the occasion of Ganga Dussehra, looked baffled as commotion reigned supreme. The wrestlers left without speaking with the media. Several other khap leaders and Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann also came out in support of the wrestlers but urged them to show restraint. "The wrestlers have said they will immerse their medals in Ganga river. We request them that these medals are the result of their hardwork, sacrifices of their families and support from society... they should not take this step.

"It is unfortunate that those who represented the nation in top international tournaments that they are forced to take such decisions. The government should have some shame and give justice to them," Khap leader Balwant Nambardar said.

**'Allegations serious'...**

Sisodia was arrested by the CBI on February 26. The high court said the allegations against him are very serious in nature. Citing the allegations against the AAP leader, it said, the excise policy was formed at the instance of the "South Group" with malafide intention to give undue advantage to them. "Such an act points towards the misconduct of the applicant, who was admittedly a public servant and holding highest position. The statement of the concerned excise officers has been relied upon by the CBI," it said.

**Will return awards...**

"We have submitted a copy of the memorandum to Chief Minister N Biren Singh. He has assured us of arranging a meeting with Shah in the evening after his return from Churachandpur. We will handover the memorandum to him then," Chanu said. The memorandum is also signed by other Arjun awardees from the state. They are Oinam Benbem Devi (also Padma Shri), N Soniya Chanu, M Biojit Singh, Y Sanathoi Devi, L Shushila Devi and M Suranjoy Singh.

In the memorandum, the sportspersons questioned the central security forces in controlling the violence despite "Kuki terrorists challenging the integrity of Manipur" by killing people and burning houses. "We condemn such attacks on unarmed civilians, specially in the peripheral areas of the valley districts," they added. The sportspersons demanded revocation of the Suspension of Operation (SoO) agreement with Kuki militant groups, restoration of peace and normalcy at the earliest and protection of unity and integrity of Manipur. "The demand to disintegrate Manipur is not acceptable under any circumstances," the memorandum said and demanded deportation of all illegal immigrants. The sports personalities also urged the government to lift the blockade on NH 2 as it has led to skyrocketing of prices of essential commodities.

The highway runs from Dibrugarh in Assam to Tuipang in Mizoram. It passes through Assam, Nagaland, Manipur and Mizoram. "Meiteis are allowed to settle only in the valley which constitutes just about 10 per cent of the total geographical area of Manipur. Where will they settle after some years if the present system is allowed to continue? So, allow Meiteis to settle in the hills of Manipur," the memorandum added.

**Cong govt issued...**

In the presentation, information about the installation of statues was given. Singh further said agreement for construction of Mahakal Lok was inked between Congress government and the M/s MP Babria, DH Patel and Gayatri Electricals.

Singh said there was no corruption in the corridor construction. The way the Congress is making allegations against the government indicates that they were involved in corruption, Singh said, adding that if necessary, there will be an inquiry into the case.

The cost of more than 100 idols was Rs 7.75 crore and that the contractor concerned will replace the damaged idols with the new ones, he said.

The Congress is doing dirty politics over the issue, but they should provide evidence of corruption, Singh said.

Around 150 medical colleges across country may lose recognition

Around 150 medical colleges of the country are likely to lose recognition of the National Medical Commission -- the regulatory body for country's medical education and medical professionals -- for inadequate faculty and non-compliance of rules. Already, 40 medical colleges have lost recognition and must show to the NMC that they are following set standards.

The list of colleges on the NMC's radar includes medical colleges in Gujarat, Assam, Puducherry, Tamil

Nadu, Punjab, Andhra Pradesh, Tripura and West Bengal. The deficiencies were revealed during an inspection carried out by the Undergraduate Medical Education Board of the Commission for over a month, in which they looked into CCTV cameras, lapses in Adhar linked biometric attendance procedures and

the faculty rolls. Sources said the colleges were not following the criteria to run a medical college, including proper camera installation and their functioning. Biometric facility was not working properly. Many posts in the faculties were also found vacant during the inspection. The medical colleges have the option to appeal, sources said. The first appeal can be made at the NMC within 30 days. If the appeal is rejected, they can approach the Union Ministry of Health.

MANIPUR VIOLENCE

HM announces Rs 10 lakh for victims' families

**IMPHAL:** Union Home Minister Amit Shah, who had already held a half a dozen meetings since his arrival in violence-hit Manipur on Monday night, on Tuesday visited Churachandpur, one of the districts severely affected by the ethnic violence that ravaged the state since May 3, leaving at least 75 dead and over 300 injured. According to a senior Manipur government official, during a meeting between the Home Minister and state council of ministers headed by the Chief Minister, it was decided to give compensation of Rs 10 lakh each to those who died during the ethnic violence.

A government job would also be provided to a kin of the family whose members were killed in the violence. The compensation amount would be equally borne by the Centre and the state. Officials said that in the tribal-dominated Churachandpur, Shah held meetings with various Civil Society Organisations (CSOs), influential tribal leaders and local security and civil administrations officials. "This crucial engagement aims to study the

actual situation in ground zero and gather inputs and better understand the challenges faced by the affected communities," a government official said in Imphal.

He said that the Home Minister is likely to chair an all party meeting in Imphal on Tuesday or Wednesday as part of the efforts to bring peace and normalcy in the northeastern state, where a large number of government and non-government properties, and nearly 1,800 houses destroyed in the ethnic hostilities.

Vinesh Phogat has won two World Championship medals, two medals at Asiad and three Commonwealth Games medals. Bajrang Punia has won an Olympic bronze, four World Championships medals, two Asian Games and three Commonwealth Games medals.

“What use is a life lived compromising on your self-respect,” a letter in Hindi, tweeted by the top athletes who have been leading the protests since earlier this year, said. A letter explained they had wondered whom to return the medals to before deciding to immerse them in the Ganges. “The President, who is a woman herself, sat barely two kilometres away and watched when they were roughened up by men in khaki. She didn’t say anything,” the letter said, on why they didn’t feel like returning the medals to her. The wrestlers also accused the Prime Minister of not asking about them “even once”. “Instead, our oppressor (Brij Bhushan Singh) was at the inauguration of the new Parliament building in dazzling white clothes, getting pictures clicked. This white was stinging us as if it was saying ‘I am the system,’” the letter, tweeted by the top grapplers further said. “We don’t need these medals anymore because this system feeds on its own propaganda by hanging them around our necks and putting a mask,” the letter said. “They then exploit us, and put us in jail if we protest,” it added. The wrestlers said they have chosen the Ganga River as it is “our mother”. Just as they consider Ganga sacred, the medals too have a certain sanctity. And the holy river is the appropriate resting place for them, it was reasoned. The letter began by accusing the police of brutally cracking down on their “peaceful” protest march, ransacking their protest site, and filing FIRs in serious cases against them. “The police and the system are treating us as criminals while the harasser openly attacks us in public meetings,” the letter said.

The Delhi Police had accused the protesting wrestlers of breaching the barricades and rioting, a charge that has been refuted. Earlier this month, the ace wrestlers alleged that a group of drunk Delhi Police personnel targeted them when they went to bring in mattresses to sleep on a rainy day. The policemen beat them up and abused the women wrestlers, they had said. Several grapplers were hit on the

head and two of them sustained injuries. One person had to be taken to the hospital.

### DIGNITY OF WOMEN...

This is an affront to all women of India.

It is not a political issue, but one which affects the dignity of all women,” she observed. “The registration of the FIR appears to be only a formality. The central government is not at all serious about taking action under law against Brij Bhushan, who has a criminal record. We will not be silent spectators to this display of arrogance,” she noted. Patkar said on June 1 all trade unions, farmers associations, women’s organisations and NGOs will hold demonstrations across the country in support of the protesting wrestlers. “This will be a national movement,” she added. The issue is gaining traction in all the states and the government will have no choice but to arrest the BJP functionary and make him stand trial, she stated.

### Charge sheet filed in IIT...

Solanki’s Instagram chat dates back to a few days before his suicide. The teen had confided to the person online that he was in a lot of trouble, that the nature of a close family member was not good and that was the reason he had purposely obtained admission to a college where he could be away from home. He said further that he was not able to study and unable to score too, because of which, he said, he was “again going into depression”. He had sought guidance from the other person to improve his marks, the charge sheet said.

The police had arrested Solanki’s batchmate Arman Khatri and booked him for abetment to suicide, among other offences under the SC/ST Act. The chargesheet claims Khatri had threatened Solanki with a paper cutter after a tiff over remarks the latter had made on his religion, because of which Solanki was frightened, which led to the act. It also mentions in his conversations with some students, Solanki had said he was afraid Khatri would harm him.

Khatri, an 18-year-old, secured bail earlier this month from the special court. While giving him relief, the court had said that there was nothing to show he had harassed Solanki on caste grounds.

Police have recorded the statements of 55 witnesses – 14 of whom are students – most of them who lived on the eighth floor of the hostel, where Solanki resided too. The chargesheet also contains the statements of seven professors of the institute. Their statements concerned Solanki’s studies and his performance.

Some witnesses spoke about Darshan shivering when Arman threatened him and others trying to comfort him, the chargesheet said. Solanki had told some witnesses that Khatri was influential and would not spare him, the chargesheet claimed. He wanted to leave Mumbai but was scared that Khatri would come after him even then, some witnesses allegedly told the SIT.

Referring to certain phone chats between Solanki and Khatri, police said it was clear that Darshan was apologising for the alleged communal remark he had made.

Solanki, a first-year BTech (Chemical) student from Ahmedabad, Gujarat, allegedly jumped to death from the seventh floor of a hostel building on the IIT Bombay campus, Powai, on February 12, 2023, a day after the semester exams ended.

Three weeks later, the SIT found a one-line note from Solanki’s room that said “Arman has killed me”.

On February 11 and 12 Solanki had fever, and his roommate gave him a blanket; it is assumed that he wrote the note mentioning Khatri on the back of a question paper before ending his life, the chargesheet said.

### No runaway brides...

The elevator moved skywards but got stuck between the ground and the first floor, leading to momentary chaos; even more unnerving was the nagging fear of missing the 9 pm auspicious slot for wedding rituals. The fire brigade personnel were informed and they rushed to the spot, rescued the bride, her siblings and relatives with the help of technicians. All, just in time; the minors who complained of dehydration were taken to a nearby hospital and discharged after a routine check-up. The groom, relatives and guests heaved a sigh of relief.

Two Hours Earlier.....

The other incident was reported the same day from Walchand Nagar in Rai village near Bhayandar at around 6:15 pm. This time the bride accidentally got locked up in the flat while the beautician was doing her bridal make-up for the reception. The family had already left for the reception venue, leaving the bride behind for inexplicable reasons. Luckily, a fireman attached to the MBMC who stays in the same building heard the screams and immediately summoned his colleagues from the fire station. Both were rescued and, thankfully, reached the venue on time.

### Larger public interest ...

However, he claimed that till date MMRDA had not provided him with any details of the rehab tenement. He categorically stated that he was entitled for monetary compensation for loss/ damage of the

structure which would be required to be removed.

Patil further argued that Satguru Corporate Services Pvt. Ltd. could not claim the entire compensation.

The court, however, refused to decide apportionment of compensation or any entitlement or declaration in this petition.

The court noted that Nagori’s claim that he ought to have been awarded compensation first and only then he would vacate the land was “totally untenable”. “There cannot be quid pro quo of such a nature as canvassed on behalf of the petitioner, more particularly when the project in question is in the interest of public at large, as also considering that the petitioner has accepted the notice dated 30 January, 2012,” averred the bench.

It was only in 2019, that Nagori made a representation to MMRDA for rehabilitation. “This would fully indicate that the petitioner has in totality accepted the notice dated 30 January,

2012...” the bench added, while dismissing the plea.

### 50% discount for...

“This important decision holds immense potential to enhance the quality of life for residents of existing tenements. It not only prioritises safety but also ensures the provision of adequate parking facilities, which are crucial aspects of urban planning. Moreover, the move discourages fragmented development of stand-alone buildings lacking proper infrastructure while encouraging the adoption of cluster development, which offers numerous advantages,” said Dominic Romell, President, CREDAI-MCHI.

In another move, last week, the Maharashtra government’s housing department had issued a resolution to provide tenements to slum dwellers residing in them prior to January 1, 2011, by charging them Rs 2.5 lakh. This decision will involve slums dating from January 1, 2000 to January

1, 2011. The government had to levy a charge as they did not fit into the “eligible slum dwellers” category.

### Bid to unnerve...

In an editorial comment on Monday, the Thackeray mouthpiece “Saamana” said another key leader of the Shinde group, Gajanan Kirtikar, is openly voicing his dissatisfaction over the BJP’s purportedly “discriminating” attitude. Among other things, Kirtikar has voiced his resentment over how the major public issues related to their respective constituencies remain unresolved as the clock ticks away for the next elections in 2024.

The Shiv Sena has expressed its desire to contest 22 of the 48 Lok Sabha seats in the state, not realising that the BJP is not too inclined to share political space with allies in the long run. This has manifested on the national canvas in its attitude towards its erstwhile allies like the Akali Dal, Nitish Kumar’s JD(U) and the Thackeray’s UBT.

“On Saturday night, Nepali had opened fire on a paan vendor named Shahil on the Bahadurpur railway over bridge, who died on the spot. Few hours later, he smashed the butt of a gun on the head of a railway employee near the Rajendra Nagar railway station and fled with his mobile phone. The victim is presently undergoing treatment,” said Sandeep Singh, SP (Central).
